E-safety

In recent weeks, Miss Woodward has been updating the E-Safety page of the website. The page contains links for parents to internet safety advice websites, including a few which were not previously on there. It also gives information about social media age restrictions and what PEGI symbols mean on computer games. Furthermore, it explains what each class has received this year with regards to E-Safety education so that parents can discuss this further with their children and reinforce the rules at home. On the page, there are also a number of documents which have been uploaded with 'top tips' for children's use of social media platforms (such as Instagram, Snapchat and WhatsApp) as well as documents providing advice for parents about catfishing, age- ratings and screen addiction. The Momo Challenge

This week, we have been informed about 'The Momo Challenge' and a number of children have mentioned it in school. Momo is something that can appear when children are watching videos on Youtube (including the children's version) and it has also been seen on other video applications. It sets children a series of challenges which would cause themselves or others harm.

On Wednesday, following several children mentioning Momo during the day, Miss Crumbleholme spoke to Class 2 and Miss Woodward spoke to Class 3. They questioned children about what they should do if something 'pops up' on their screen which they are not expecting. Children were confident in relaying the strategies that they have been taught: tell a trusted adult and not click on any pop-ups.

On the school Facebook page it provides further details about Momo and a parent guide can be found on there so that you are able to talk with confidence about this issue at home.

We are advising parents to remove Youtube from devices for the time being and carefully monitor their children's use of tablets, mobile phones, laptops and personal computers. We also advise children that they should only use devices in the presence of adults and many have reported to us that this is a rule at home.

REQUESTS FOR ABSENCE

From 1st September 2013, the headteacher will not grant *any* leave of absence during term time unless there are exceptional circumstances. It is important for parents to understand that they have no entitlement to take their child out of school for a holiday in term time. Peover Superior uses a specific request form for any absences. We believe this complies with current regulations. This form can be found on the website.

Fixed Penalty Notices

The LA will issue Fixed Penalty Notices related to irregular unauthorised absences and unauthorised. Failure to make payment will result in the LA taking legal action for failure to ensure regular attendance at school under Section 444 (1) Education Act 1996.
