



We are very proud to announce that Peover Superior Primary School has been rated Outstanding once again by Ofsted, an outcome achieved by only 17% of schools.

The report states that: -

“Pupils are very enthusiastic about coming to Peover Superior Primary School. Those who spoke with inspectors said that they feel safe and happy there. They talked about how it is reassuring to have a trusted adult who will help them if they have any worries. Relationships between staff and pupils are very warm and friendly”.

“Leaders’ expectations for pupils’ work and behaviour are high. Pupils respond extremely well to these expectations. They work hard and show highly positive attitudes to their learning”.

“Teachers have a deep understanding of the curriculum and how to teach it. They have a highly secure knowledge of the subjects that they teach. They use a range of very effective methods to assess how well pupils have remembered what they have learned”.

Request for Absence

The Principal will not grant **any** leave of absence during term time unless there are exceptional circumstances. It is important for parents to understand that they have no entitlement to take their child out of school for a holiday in term time. Peover Superior uses a specific request form for any absences. We believe this complies with current regulations. This form can be found on the website.

We are receiving a large volume of holiday requests during term time, please be aware that these are unauthorised and the LA will issue Fixed Penalty Notices related to irregular unauthorised absences.

Failure to make payment will result in the LA taking legal action for failure to ensure regular attendance at school under Section 444 (1) Education Act 1996.

Friendly Reminders



The rear car park gates at school are only to be used by those requiring disabled access and for the school taxi. This is to ensure the safety of all children.

Parking

During the restricted times shown on the signs, you are **not allowed to stop on zig zags or yellow lines** even just for a minute to drop a child off.

Always check the time restrictions on the signs.

Zig zag markings and other parking restrictions are there to protect children. If you ignore the restrictions, you risk hurting children

Advice to those bringing dogs to school at drop off and pick up times

Dogs are an important part of family life for many in the school community, and as such are often included in day-to-day activities such as walking children to and from school. However, others may find the presence of dogs stressful, even frightening. Consequently, **dogs are not permitted** onto the school site. Furthermore, dogs are not to be left tied up unattended to the fence. The school's priority is the safeguarding of all its children and staff.
