Request for Absence

The Principal will not grant **any** leave of absence during term time unless there are exceptional circumstances. It is important for parents to understand that they have no entitlement to take their child out of school for a holiday in term time. Peover Superior uses a specific request form for any absences. We believe this complies with current regulations. This form can be found on the website.

We are receiving a large volume of holiday requests during term time, please be aware that these are unauthorised and the LA will issue Fixed Penalty Notices related to irregular unauthorised absences.

Failure to make payment will result in the LA taking legal action for failure to ensure regular attendance at school under Section 444 (1) Education Act 1996.

Friendly Reminders

- As we are entering Autumn please could you ensure that children have the suitable outdoor wear for the changes in weather in order to keep them warm and dry
- Please can children have their water bottles with them daily and a healthy option break-time snack - **this should be an appropriate portion so that our children eat and enjoy their lunchtime meal.**
- Just a friendly reminder that the back gate will be open each morning and after school for the school taxi and for disabled access use only. This is to ensure safety of all children.
- **Please remember that dogs are not allowed on our school premises - thank you for your support with this.**

Collecting Children

A polite reminder that if another adult is collecting your child from school please ring or email in to the office to inform Janet. The class teacher will then be made aware of this. If a message is not received we will not release your child until we have contacted you.

Appointments with Teachers

If at any time you would like to meet with one of our teachers to discuss anything at all, please could you book an appointment slot through Janet. Due to time constraints in the morning these appointments will be held after school.

Safeguarding: Please could we ask that all parents refrain from entering the main school building or the cabin unless they have an appointment with the Class Teacher, Mrs Munro or Janet.

Reading to your child

It might seem like everything has gone digital, but books still play a very important part in school life. As well as giving your child a head start, developing a love of reading can be really enjoyable.



Make books and stories part of everyday life:

- Build a reading story into a routine, e.g. a story at bedtime.
- Stick your feet up and let your child see you reading a book.
- Go to the library so your child can choose some books to borrow for free.
- Read in fun places, e.g. a den made from blankets.
- Give books as birthday presents - this will show you value them.
- Keep books in your bag or the car.

Safeguarding Tip

Online safety

This week our safeguarding focus is on online safety. Children have access to a multitude of information at their fingertips. They live in a world where knowing how to operate in the digital world is just as important as knowing how to be vigilant and safe in public. In school, we carry out lots of work on online safety throughout the curriculum and the children are always reminded about the key messages around privacy and not sharing information. As parents please ensure that any devices that the children have access to at home have parental controls installed and that you are aware of what the children are accessing and who they are talking to. It is good advice to ask them to use their devices in the same room as you so that you are present and able to support if they find themselves in an uncomfortable situation.

Welcome to our 'Online Safety Tip of The Week'. On each newsletter, we will provide you with some useful hints, tips, guides and fact sheets from the [National Online Safety \(NOS\)](#) website that you as parents and carers will be able to use to help keep your child safe whilst online.



This week's free online safety guide focuses on [Amigo](#). Amigo, which has a recommended age rating of 18+, is a social platform which purports to connect strangers from different countries around the world using built-in translation software. Focussing heavily on one-to-one chat, video calls and live streams, Amigo encourages its users to build up online relationships and unlock exclusive features such as private video and audio calls: essentially, the more you chat, the more features become available, thus it is definitely not recommended for children!
