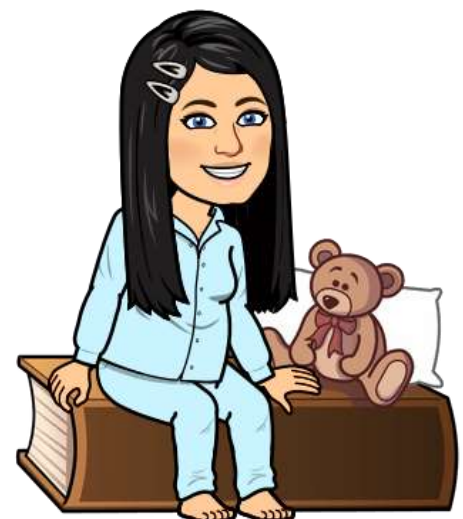

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Important Reminders

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Request for Absence

The Principal will not grant **any** leave of absence during term time unless there are exceptional circumstances. It is important for parents to understand that they have no entitlement to take their child out of school for a holiday in term time. Peover Superior uses a specific request form for any absences. We believe this complies with current regulations. This form can be found on the website.

We are receiving a large volume of holiday requests during term time, please be aware that these are unauthorised and the LA will issue Fixed Penalty Notices related to irregular unauthorised absences.

Failure to make payment will result in the LA taking legal action for failure to ensure regular attendance at school under Section 444 (1) Education Act 1996.

Friendly Reminders

- As we are entering Autumn please could you ensure that children have the suitable outdoor wear for the changes in weather in order to keep them warm and dry
- Please can children have their water bottles with them daily and a healthy option break-time snack - **this should be an appropriate portion so that our children eat and enjoy their lunchtime meal.**
- Just a friendly reminder that the back gate will be open each morning and after school for the school taxi and for disabled access use only. This is to ensure safety of all children.
- **Just a friendly reminder that dogs are not allowed on our school premises - thank you for your support with this.**

Collecting Children

A polite reminder that if another adult is collecting your child from school, that you ring in to the office to inform Janet.

The class teacher will then be made aware of this. If a message is not received we will not release your child until we have contacted you.

Appointments with Teachers

If at any time you would like to meet with one of our teachers to discuss anything at all, please could you book an appointment slot through Janet. Due to time constraints in the morning these appointments will be held after school.

Safeguarding: Please could we ask that all parents refrain from entering the main school building or the cabin unless they have an appointment with the Class Teacher, Mrs Munro or Janet.

Reading to your child

It might seem like everything has gone digital, but books still play a very important part in school life. As well as giving your child a head start, developing a love of reading can be really enjoyable.



Make books and stories part of everyday life:

- Build a reading story into a routine, e.g. a story at bedtime.
- Stick your feet up and let your child see your reading a book.
- Go to the library so your child can choose some books to borrow for free.
- Read in fun places, e.g. a den made from blankets.
- Give books as birthday presents - this will show you value them.
- Keep books in your bag or the car.

Online Safety Tip of the Week

This week's free online safety guide, provided by the [National Online Safety \(NOS\)](#) website, focuses on [NGL](#) (Not Gonna Lie). NGL, which is aimed at children 13 plus, is an app through which users share a link to their Instagram story or Twitter account, inviting their followers to give anonymous feedback.

The app includes some prewritten questions (such as 'if you could change anything about me, what would it be?'), plus an option to ask followers to simply 'send me anonymous messages' with all of the replies going anonymously to the user's NGL inbox...



Safeguarding Tip of the Week

Advice for parents at the start of the school year

It is common for children to feel nervous about going back to school after summer holidays. To help calm their nerves and make sure they're prepared for the school term make sure:

- Bedtimes are adjusted to get back into a healthy routine
- Children are not taking any devices like mobile phones or tablets to bed with them that will stop them from sleeping
- They eat breakfast every morning.



Talk to your children about their day at school. It is important that they can talk to you if they are worried about anything.
