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Request for Absence

The Principal will not grant **any** leave of absence during term time unless there are exceptional circumstances. It is important for parents to understand that they have no entitlement to take their child out of school for a holiday in term time. Peover Superior uses a specific request form for any absences. We believe this complies with current regulations. This form can be found on the website.

We are receiving a large volume of holiday requests during term time, please be aware that these are unauthorised and the LA will issue Fixed Penalty Notices related to irregular unauthorised absences. Failure to make payment will result in the LA taking legal action for failure to ensure regular attendance at school under Section 444 (1) Education Act 1996.

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British Values Focus of the Week

Online Safety Tip of the Week

This week's free online safety guide, provided by the <u>National Online Safety (NOS)</u> website, focuses on the <u>'Dangers of Vaping'</u>. Despite helping thousands of people successfully quit smoking and being found to be up to 95% less harmful than cigarettes, data collected for <u>ASH</u> shows an increase in 11-17-year-olds experimenting with vaping. It is now believed that almost 12% of 11-17 are accessing these age

restricted products, with the nicotine reported to be detrimental to brain development and cause long term addiction. Raising awareness of the risks among young people could help to

reduce the number of young vapers...

It might seem like everything has gone digital, but books still play a very important part in school life. As well as giving your child a head start, developing a love of reading can be really enjoyable.



Make books and stories part of everyday life:

- Build a reading story into a routine, e.g. a story at bedtime.

- Keep books in your bag or the car.
