#### **Request for Absence**

We believe this complies with current regulations. This form can be found on the website.

We are receiving a large volume of holiday requests during term time, please be aware that these are unauthorised and the LA will issue Fixed Penalty Notices related to irregular unauthorised absences.

Failure to make payment will result in the LA taking legal action for failure to ensure regular attendance at school under Section 444 (1) Education Act 1996.

### Online Safety Tip of the Week

This week's free online safety guide, provided by the <u>National Online Safety (NOS)</u> website, focuses on <u>YouTube Kids</u>. YouTube Kids is a kid-targeted version of YouTube that features curated, ad-supported TV shows, music, educational videos, and user-created content. It's designed for kids preschool age to age 12 and is

available as an app and a website. YouTube Kids allows ou to create individual user profiles for

each of your kids, so they can each log in and watch videos geared toward their age. One of the best features of YouTube Kids is the timer, which lets you set a limit (up to an hour) for your kids to play on the app.

### Safeguarding Tip of the Week

This week's safeguarding focus is mental health. Mental health is about our moods, feelings and emotions. Recognising the signs that a child may be struggling with their mental health can be really hard and it is important that we talk about mental health with our children. Below are some tips to support you with these conversations:

- · Make conversations about mental health a normal part of life
- · Give it your full attention be an active listener
- Take it seriously and explore the feelings together
- Offer empathy rather than solutions
