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Important Reminders

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School Attendance, including Persistent Absences and Holidays during Term Time

Following an attendance review from Cheshire East we have been notified that when a pupil's unauthorised leave reaches (not exceeds) 10 sessions (5 days) in any one academic year it will be necessary to discuss the matter with the Local Authority (Education Welfare Service) and to issue a Fixed Penalty Notice (FPN). Further info on school website.

Timeline	Penalty Charges
Paid within 21 days	£60 per parent per child
After 21 days and before 28 days	£120 per parent per child
After 28 days	The parent will receive a summons to appear before the Magistrate's Court on the grounds of having failed to secure their child/ children's regular attendance

Friendly Reminders

- As we are entering Spring please could you ensure that children have the suitable outdoor wear for the changes in weather in order to keep them warm and dry
- Please can children have their water bottles with them daily and a healthy option break-time snack - *this should be an appropriate portion so that our children eat and enjoy their lunchtime meal.*
- Just a friendly reminder that the back gate will be open each morning and after school for the school taxi and for disabled access use only. This is to ensure safety of all children.
- **Just a friendly reminder that dogs are not allowed on our school premises - thank you for your support with this.**

During drop off and pick up times, our playground area is busy and we kindly ask that children **do not** use the Astroturf area for ball games as we have had a few incidences where children and adults have been hurt by footballs, which had been kicked very hard.

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A Friendly Reminder about Reading...

We have noticed that reading at home has declined this half term across school. We would like to take this opportunity to remind you about the importance of reading regularly with and to your children. We want to foster the love of reading with all of our pupils. The Reading Champions have set the children a reading challenge for over the Easter holidays. Each completed challenge is worth a house point - this is a great opportunity to earn extra points for your team!

Read for 20 minutes a day for 5 consecutive days.

Read and follow instructions to make something.

Write an engaging summary of the last chapter you read.

Draw a story map about your favourite book.

Read a story that makes you laugh.

Write a letter to the author about their book.

Find and copy five great descriptive adjectives.

Video yourself making a book review.

Read in the dark, using a torch.

Design a new front cover for your book.

Make a **comic strip** showing an important part of the book you are reading now.

Read to someone over the phone or on video chat.

Find the meaning of some unfamiliar words and use them in a sentence.

Predict what would happen in the next book of the series and write its blurb.

Read a story about another country and mark it on a **map**.

Online Safety Tip of the Week

Welcome to our 'Online Safety Tip of The Week'. On each newsletter, we will provide you with some useful hints, tips, guides and fact sheets from the [National Online Safety \(NOS\) website](#) that you as parents and carers will be able to use to help keep your child safe whilst online. This week's free online safety guide focuses on [NGL](#) (Not Gonna Lie). NGL, which is aimed at children 13 plus, is an app through which users share a link to their Instagram story or Twitter account, inviting their followers to give anonymous feedback. The app includes some prewritten questions (such as 'if you could change anything about me, what would it be?'), plus an option to ask followers to simply 'send me anonymous messages'. All replies go into the user's NGL inbox, with the sender remaining anonymous, although subscribers can receive hints...



Healthy Snacks

Busy brains and growing bodies need the right fuel to power through a packed school day! Just like a superhero's energy source, what we eat matters. That's why we wanted to send a friendly reminder about choosing healthy snacks for our remarkable pupils at Peover.

A healthy snack should be:

Packed with power: Choose foods rich in protein, fibre, and good fats - like cheese slices with whole-wheat crackers, hummus and vegetable sticks, or yoghurt with berries.

Rainbow bright: Fill your child's snack box with colourful fruits and vegetables - think crunchy carrot sticks, juicy grapes (need to be sliced), choppers peppers or cherry tomatoes!
