Message from Mrs Munro

As we head into the last few days of this academic year, I reflect with such pride on our wonderful school and the outstanding achievements of all our children. Last week, I reported the amazing results our children had achieved across the school. This week, I am pleased to share the highlights from our Year 6 SATs results.

I am delighted to announce that 100% of our Year 6 children achieved the expected standard in Reading, Writing, and Maths. This is a tremendous achievement and a true reflection of their hard work throughout their time at Peover. Miss Downing and Mrs. Whiles have led the Year 6's to achieve great success this year. Achieving their KS2 SATs is an amazing accomplishment, but they don't reflect what wonderful individuals our Year 6 children are—kind, funny, thoughtful, and above all, extraordinary. As we celebrate their academic success, let's also acknowledge the character and spirit of our children. They have shown resilience, kindness, and a strong sense of community. We are incredibly proud of each and every one of them and I'm sure you will join me in congratulating our year 6 children on their OUTSTANDING results!

Thank you to Libby (Year 4) for her wonderful book donation purchased with the £120 she raised for the school. Libby was very keen to purchase something everyone would enjoy, and as a school that LOVES books, this was her obvious choice. She went to Waterstones with her fundraising money and bought over 20 new books for the school, for all ages to read, enjoy, and share.

This week, I would like to inform you in advance of the changes happening from September regarding our after-school sports clubs. As a school, we currently fund these clubs through our sports funding. However, due to the success of our Sports Week and the feedback from our children about the different sporting events and visitors they encountered and thoroughly enjoyed, we will be putting our sports funding towards more sporting opportunities that will benefit all of our children. Therefore, there will be a charge for the after-school clubs. Our provider of these clubs - Sports Coaching Group charge £5 a session with discounts for siblings and all payments will be made through them and not through school. Miss Oakley will be delivering an assembly about the after school sports clubs on offer from September onwards during next week's whole school assembly.

Finally, I would like to thank everyone who attended our school fair. It was wonderful to see so many families on our school playground and field enjoying the array of stalls and activities. Thank you to the PTA and parent volunteers for helping us to organise the fair. It is always wonderful to have everyone together at Peover, and listening to the laughter and watching the excitement, fun, and camaraderie really does show the special community we have here at Peover.

Next week, our wonderful KS2 children have their Matilda productions and I am incredibly excited to watch this alongside their families and members of our Academy Trust. Once again, our wonderful PTA will be providing refreshments at all the performances. Thank you to the KS2 teaching teams for all their hardwork in putting this together.

PENALTY NOTICE FINES FOR SCHOOL ATTENDANCE ARE CHANGING !

With the introduction of the new National Framework for Penalty Notices, the following changes will come into force on 19 August 2024.

Penalty Notices will be issued for

Term time leave: Penalty Notice fines will be issued for term time leave of 5 or more consecutive days.

10 Sessions of Unauthorised absence in a rolling 10 week period: A Penalty Notices may be considered when there have been 10 sessions of unauthorised absences in a 10 week period.

However, we retain the discretion to issue a Penalty Notice before the threshold is met. For

Per Parent/Per Child

Penalty Notice fines will continue to be issued per parent per child. For example: 3 siblings absent for term time leave, would result in each parent receiving 3 separate fines.

First Offence

The first time a Penalty Notice is issued for term time leave or irregular school attendance the fine will be charged at:

£160 per parent, per child if paid within 28 days of the issue, reducing to £80 per parent, per child if paid within 21 days.

(Unpaid penalty notices may result in a parental prosecution)

Second Offence

Where it is deemed appropriate to issue a second penalty notice to the same parent for the same pupil within 3 years of the first penalty notice, for either term time leave or irregular attendance the second penalty notice will be charged at:

£160 if paid within 28 days. (Unpaid penalty notices may result in a parental prosecution)

Third Offence

On the third time that an offence is committed within 3 years of the first penalty notice for either a term time leave or irregular attendance a penalty notice will not be issued. The case may proceed to Parental Prosecution under the Single Justice Procedure. If found guilty of the offence of 'Failure to send a child to school' the Magistrates can impose a fine up to £1000 or legal proceedings under Section 444 (1a) can include a fine of up to £2500.

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Online Safety Tip of the Week

This week's free online safety guide focuses on [Group Chats](#). Occurring through messaging apps, on social media and in online games, group chats are among the most popular ways that young people engage with their peers online. Involving, by definition, three or more

Individuals, these groups allow users to send messages, images and videos to everyone in one place. While they are useful for helping friends, people with shared interests or members of a club to communicate and coordinate activities, they can also leave young people feeling excluded and bullied.



Safeguarding Tip of the Week

Self Esteem

Self-esteem is about valuing yourself as a whole person. Here's how you can support yourselves and your children in this journey. Celebrate strengths and uniqueness – we need to ensure we focus on what makes each person special, their talents, and their positive qualities. Uniform Reminders

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Peover Superior Endowed Primary School Uniform

Our school uniform is as follows:

- School navy blue jumper or cardigan with school logo
- Pale blue cotton shirt (long or short sleeve)
- Blue and gold striped tie
- School book bag with school logo
- Grey trousers, skirt, shorts or skorts
- Black shoes
- Light blue gingham dresses/playsuits in the summer.

PE kits

School navy blue T-shirt with school logo

- Navy blue shorts
- School gym bag with school logo
- Suitable trainers
- Suitable sports footwear, e.g. football boots, shin pads when necessary

Parents/carers are responsible for ensuring their child brings their PE kit to school when needed.

Footwear

Black shoes should be worn. Pupils are not permitted to wear boots. If a pupil needs to wear wellington boots or warm boots to travel to school in comfort, they must have their normal school shoes with them to change into.

Block heels of no more than 3cm may be worn.

Jewellery

One pair of stud earrings – no other piercings are acceptable.

Pupils are not permitted to wear any other jewellery in the academy grounds, with the exception of a watch, due to health and safety risks.

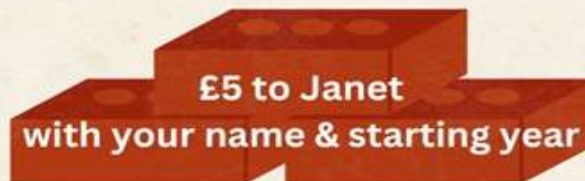
