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PENALTY NOTICE FINES FOR SCHOOL ATTENDANCE ARE CHANGING !

With the introduction of the new National Framework for Penalty Notices, the following changes will come into force on 19 August 2024.

Penalty Notices will be issued for

Term time leave: Penalty Notice fines will be issued for term time leave of 5 or more consecutive days.

10 Sessions of Unauthorised absence in a rolling 10 week period: A Penalty Notices may be considered when there have been 10 sessions of unauthorised absences in a 10 week period.

However, we retain the discretion to issue a Penalty Notice before the threshold is met. For

Per Parent/Per Child

Penalty Notice fines will continue to be issued per parent per child. For example: 3 siblings absent for term time leave, would result in each parent receiving 3 separate fines.

First Offence

The first time a Penalty Notice is issued for term time leave or irregular school attendance the fine will be charged at:

£160 per parent, per child if paid within 28 days of the issue, reducing to £80 per parent, per child if paid within 21 days.

(Unpaid penalty notices may result in a parental prosecution)

Second Offence

Where it is deemed appropriate to issue a second penalty notice to the same parent for the same pupil within 3 years of the first penalty notice, for either term time leave or irregular attendance the second penalty notice will be charged at:

£160 if paid within 28 days. (Unpaid penalty notices may result in a parental prosecution)

Third Offence

On the third time that an offence is committed within 3 years of the first penalty notice for either a term time leave or irregular attendance a penalty notice will not be issued. The case may proceed to Parental Prosecution under the Single Justice Procedure. If found guilty of the offence of 'Failure to send a child to school' the Magistrates can impose a fine up to £1000 or legal proceedings under Section 444 (1a) can include a fine of up to £2500.

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Online Safety Tip of the Week

This week's free online safety guide, provided by the [National College](#), focuses on [World of Warcraft](#). Originally launched in 2004, the MMORPG (Massively Multiplayer Online Role-Playing Game), encourages players to work together to complete quests, enter dungeons and engage in player versus player (PvP) combat in the realm of Azeroth.

Due to the online nature of the game, players are required to pay a monthly subscription fee of £9.99 to play. As well as this the game includes mild violence and offensive language resulting in a suggested age rating of PEGI 12,

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Safeguarding Tip of the Week

Contextual Safeguarding

Contextual safeguarding is an approach to understanding, and responding to, young people's experiences of significant harm beyond their families. This approach recognises that the different relationships that young people form in their neighbourhoods or online can feature violence and abuse and the aim is to protect children from maltreatment, whether that is within or outside the home. Gang violence, knife crime or exploitation are all potential risks. If you are concerned about a child or young person, then you can report this to children's services or the police. You can also call the NSPCC Helpline on 0808 800 5000 to discuss any concerns.

Sleep Routine

Like everyone, children need sleep and it's really important they get it (both for them and for you). Sometimes getting them to sleep is tricky, but a predictable routine can help. It's pretty obvious that a child who is getting enough sleep is more likely to be happy and alert than a child who isn't. Getting your child into a good sleeping pattern isn't just about avoiding tantrums though, lack of sleep has been linked to future problems, such as anxiety, depression, obesity and high blood pressures.



Turn off screens an hour before bedtime. Audiobooks or good old-fashioned paper books are a good alternative to eBooks. Light from screens stops the production of the sleep hormone melatonin.

How much sleep?

As a rough guide, children need:

- 3-5 year olds = 11 - 14 hours of sleep
- 6-12 year olds = 10 - 13 hours of sleep



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Uniform Reminders

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Peover Superior Endowed Primary School Uniform

Our school uniform is as follows:

- School navy blue jumper or cardigan with school logo
- Pale blue cotton shirt (long or short sleeve)
- Blue and gold striped tie
- School book bag with school logo
- Grey trousers, skirt, shorts or skorts
- Black shoes
- Light blue gingham dresses/playsuits in the summer

PE kits

School navy blue T-shirt with school logo

- Navy blue shorts
- School gym bag with school logo
- Suitable trainers
- Suitable sports footwear, e.g. football boots, shin pads when necessary

Parents/carers are responsible for ensuring their child brings their PE kit to school when needed.

Footwear

Black shoes should be worn. Pupils are not permitted to wear boots. If a pupil needs to wear wellington boots or warm boots to travel to school in comfort, they must have their normal school shoes with them to change into.

Block heels of no more than 3cm may be worn.

Jewellery

One pair of stud earrings – no other piercings are acceptable.

Pupils are not permitted to wear any other jewellery in the academy grounds, with the exception of a watch, due to health and safety risks.
