Message from Mrs Munro

The sunny, warmer weather has allowed all our children to enjoy the beautiful outdoor spaces around school. Mrs. Whiles and Mrs. Knapper have been making great use of the new garden area for afternoon learning, where small groups of children have gathered on the benches in the sunshine to extend their learning.

At lunchtimes, Miss Oakley has organised a variety of exciting activities, including sack races, speed bounce, lacrosse, and cricket, keeping everyone active and engaged. The greenhouse has been busy with fruit and vegetable planting, and the field has become an outdoor classroom for science lessons, where many classes have been exploring nature and discovering living things and their habitats.

This week, I had the opportunity to accompany Willow and Sycamore classes on their trip to Lower Moss Wood, along with class teachers and parent volunteers. This trip provided all 43 children with a wonderful chance to immerse themselves in nature, explore woodland habitats, and deepen their understanding of the environment. Throughout the day, the children took part in wildlife spotting, pond dipping, and learning about conservation efforts. They were captivated by the diverse plant and animal life and showed great curiosity in discovering the different habitats within the woodland. It was a fantastic experience for everyone involved, and we are so proud of how engaged and enthusiastic the children were. A huge thank you to the staff and volunteers who helped make the trip such a success!

PENALTY NOTICE FINES FOR SCHOOL ATTENDANCE ARE CHANGING !

With the introduction of the new National Framework for Penalty Notices, the following changes will come into force on 19 August 2024.

Penalty Notices will be issued for

Term time leave: Penalty Notice fines will be issued for term time leave of 5 or more consecutive days.

10 Sessions of Unauthorised absence in a rolling 10 week period: A Penalty Notices may be considered when there have been 10 sessions of unauthorised absences in a 10 week period.

However, we retain the discretion to issue a Penalty Notice before the threshold is met. For

Per Parent/Per Child

Penalty Notice fines will continue to be issued per parent per child. For example: 3 siblings absent for term time leave, would result in each parent receiving 3 separate fines.

First Offence

The first time a Penalty Notice is issued for term time leave or irregular school attendance the fine will be charged at:

£160 per parent, per child if paid within 28 days of the issue, reducing to £80 per parent, per child if paid within 21 days.

(Unpaid penalty notices may result in a parental prosecution)

Second Offence

Where it is deemed appropriate to issue a second penalty notice to the same parent for the same pupil within 3 years of the first penalty notice, for either term time leave or irregular attendance the second penalty notice will be charged at:

£160 if paid within 28 days. (Unpaid penalty notices may result in a parental prosecution)

Third Offence

On the third time that an offence is committed within 3 years of the first penalty notice for either a term time leave or irregular attendance a penalty notice will not be issued. The case may proceed to Parental Prosecution under the Single Justice Procedure. If found guilty of the offence of 'Failure to send a child to school' the Magistrates can impose a fine up to £1000 or legal proceedings under Section 444 (1a) can include a fine of up to £2500.

Emotional Abuse

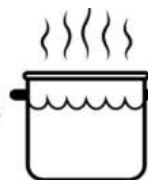
This week our safeguarding focus is '[Emotional Abuse](#)'. Emotional abuse is any type of abuse that involves the continual emotional mistreatment of a child. It's sometimes called psychological abuse. Emotional abuse can involve deliberately trying to scare, humiliate, isolate or ignore a child. Other examples are: humiliating or constantly criticising a child; blaming or scapegoating a child or exposing a child to upsetting events or situations. Because of the nature of emotional abuse, a child might not realise what is happening to them or might even blame themselves.
