Autumn Term 2 - Theme: People Who Help Us!

Computing

To Communicate
Mouse, Trackpad & Keyboard Skills

To know how to use a computer mouse and trackpad to navigate around a screen.

To know how to use a computer keyboard for typed work.

Expressive Arts - Music

Following the Charanga scheme of work, children will play rhythm games, finding the rhythm in different pieces of music. They will continue to learn nursery rhymes and how to review pieces of music.

UTW - People, Culture & Communities

Children will learn about the Christmas story and the different traditions around Christmas.

We will also learn about Diwali, the Hindu festival of light

UTW - The Natural World

In Science, the children will learn about 'Animals including Humans'. They will talk about how to care for their pets and make observations of common animals. They will learn how to describe the physical features of themselves (e.g. hair, teeth) and know some ways to look after themselves.

Expressive Art & Design

This half term, the children will research, design and make emergency vehicles out of junk modelling. They will learn to cut, assemble and join materials together. They will take photos of their finished designs and evaluate their models.

PSED

The children will explore the key question "What is money?" They will understand simple ways to earn, save and look after money. As part of our topic 'People Who Help Us', we will explore different roles in the community to help us and keep us safe.

UTW - Past & Present

The children will talk about their immediate families and the people who are special to them. We will discuss where in the world our families/extended families are from. Then the children will learn about important people in the community, as we welcome visitors into Willow class (doctors, nurses, police, farmer, postman and fire service)
