

# Curriculum Map – EYFS

Spring Term Two – Theme: Marvellous Minibeasts

## Computing

This half term the children will be learning to use different programmes on Purple Mash, such as Mashcams (taking photos), 2Beat (making musical sequences) and Simple City to create their own farms.

## Expressive Arts – Music

Following the Charanga scheme of work and the theme for this half term is 'Our world'. The children will learn how to listen and respond to music, explore playing instruments and share and perform familiar songs.

## UTW – People, Culture & Communities

The theme this half term is the Islamic celebration of Eid and the children will learn why people celebrate Eid and we will decorations for Eid.

## Physical development

Our PE days remain on a Wednesday and Friday afternoon. On a Wednesday, the children will have a **Dance** with Miss Rooks. On a Friday, the children will have a **Ball skills** lesson with Mr G.

## UTW – The Natural World

In Science, the children will be exploring **living things and their habitat**.  
They will learn what a habitat is.  
To know that a habitat is a home for animals and plants.  
To explore a variety of habitats (woodland, pond, park, under a log)  
To build a home for an animal (bug hotel etc)

## Expressive Art & Design - DT

Structures

Using natural materials to make bug houses to link in with the minibeast theme. We will look at different structures and try to understand what makes them strong and suitable.

## PSED – Making Relationships

Who is special to us and what makes a family?  
We will discuss that family is one of the groups they belong to, as well as, for example, school, friends, clubs.  
The different people in their family / those that love and care for them.  
What their family members, or people that are special to them, do to make them feel loved and cared for.  
How families are all different but share common features – what is the same and different about them.  
That it is important to tell someone (such as their teacher) if something about their family makes them feel unhappy or worried.

## UTW - History

This half term the children will explore the key question 'What has changed since our Grandparents were children?' We will talk about the changes in homes, toys, clothes and hobbies.

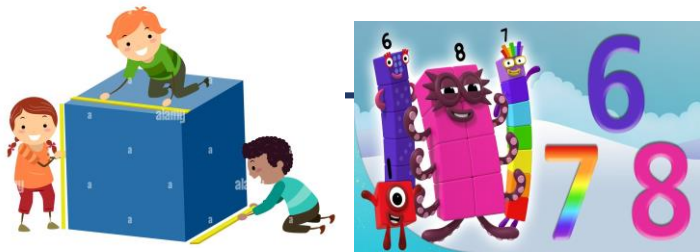
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## Maths

*This half term the children will learn:*

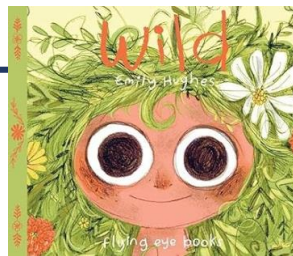
- The composition of numbers 6, 7, 8, 9 and 10 (including number bonds)
