

Curriculum Map – EYFS

Summer Term One – Theme: Under the Sea

Computing

This half term the children will be learning to use different programmes on Purple Mash, to further develop their ability to use a mouse and keyboard.

UTW - Geography

This half term the children will explore the key question 'The Wider Environment.'

The children will use secondary sources to find out about different places.

They will be able to tell you what a place is like in simple terms.

They will draw their own simple picture maps and plans with labels of places they know or imaginary places/stories.

The children will play games with globes and maps.

The children will explain some similarities and differences between these places and life in this country.

UTW – People, Culture & Communities

The theme this half term is places of worship. We will look at: Mosques, Synagogue, Church and Temples.

Physical development

Our PE days remain on a Wednesday and Friday afternoon. On a Wednesday, the children will have a **Net and wall games** with Miss Rooks. On a Friday, the children will have a **Invasion Games** with Mr G.

UTW – The Natural World

In Science, the children will be exploring **Light and Sound**.

Focussing on, understanding the terms shadow and sound.

- To know what a shadow looks like and that a shadow can be seen on a sunny day and it can change throughout the day.
- To know and name the sounds I hear by locating the source and how to make different sounds.

Expressive Art & Design - Art

Printing

Printing Explore different types of printing –direct, incised and stencil. Under the sea –printing shapes on to different media –sharing and working collaboratively.

PSED – Health and Wellbeing

Who helps to keep us Safe?

- how to respond safely to adults they don't know.
- what to do if they feel unsafe or worried for themselves or others; and the importance of keeping on asking for support until they are heard.
- how to get help if there is an accident and someone is hurt, including how to dial 999 in an emergency and what to say.
- who can help them in different places and situations; how to attract someone's attention or ask for help.

Expressive Arts – Music

Following the Charanga scheme of work and the theme for this half term is 'Big Bear Funk'. The children will learn how to listen and respond to music, explore playing instruments and share and perform familiar songs.

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Maths

This half term the children will learn:

- The composition of numbers 6, 7, 8, 9 and 10 (including number bonds)
- Being able to recall confidently number bonds to 5.
- Begin to recall number bonds to 10.
